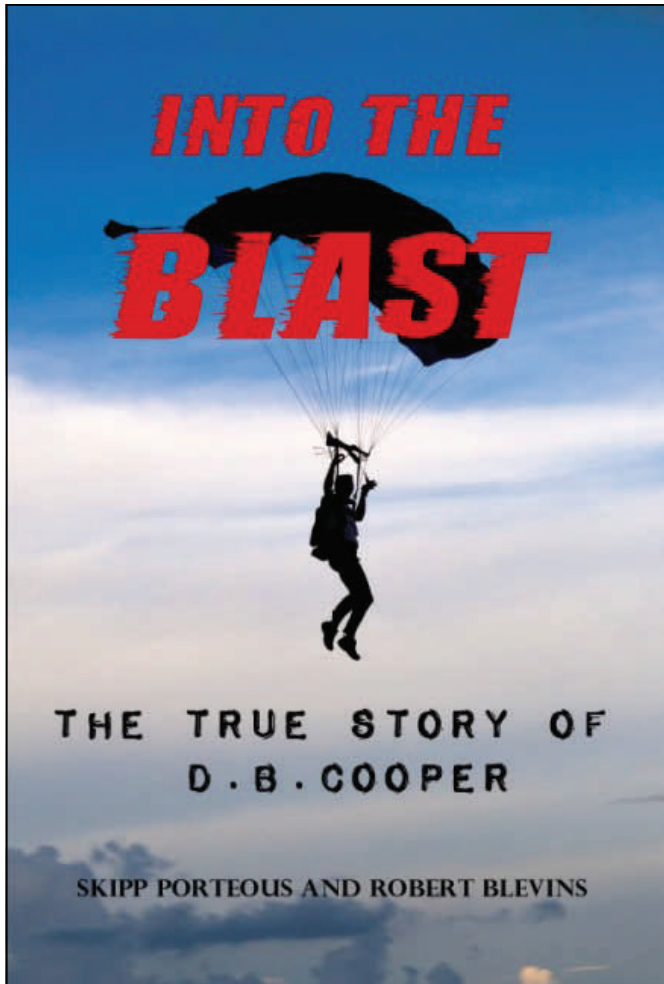

Into The Blast—The True Story of D.B. Cooper



April 25, 2010—Adventure Books of Seattle has just released a new book on the unsolved ‘D.B. Cooper’ case. In a unique collaboration between the staff of Adventure Books and Skipp Porteous of Sherlock Investigations, overwhelming evidence is presented showing that Kenneth Peter Christiansen, U.S. Army paratrooper and a former employee of Northwest Airlines, was in fact the famous hijacker.

Much of the book consists of interviews with witnesses who had never been contacted previously, as well as discussions with Bill Rataczak, the co-pilot of the hijacked jet, and former FBI agent Ralph Himmelsbach. More than thirty pictures and illustrations are included, helping detail the results of an extensive investigation into Christiansen’s life.

The book itself was created under a great deal of secrecy, and a copy of the final manuscript was provided to the offices of the Seattle F.B.I. just before release.

Into The Blast shows what motivated Christiansen to skyjack Flight 305, how he pulled it off, who helped him on the ground, and what he did with the money afterwards.
